The E12 Early Offer and Scholarship Scheme is for students from rural, regional or low socio-economic backgrounds, or those facing financial hardship. It makes your pathway to the University of Sydney easier and helps reduce the financial pressure of your first-year studies. This year, over 90 courses are offered via E12, and hundreds of students enter the University of Sydney through this scheme each year.

- A scholarship valued at \$5950
- An Early Conditional Offer to the University by mid-November
- Formal UAC offer in the main offer round by meeting a reduced E12 ATAR
- The Vice Chancellor's Global Mobility Award, valued at up to \$5000 for eligible exchange programs

- Eligibility to apply for additional accommodation scholarships
- Support through your transition from school to university through our Prep for Sydney uni program
- University of Sydney Union Access Rewards membership for your first year
