ePlatform Wheelers eBook and Audio Book Platform

LOGIN

Again we are offering students access to Audio and eBooks online. Through ePlatform, students are able to browse for, borrow and read eBooks and Audio Books anywhere, anytime and on multiple devices. ePlatform is a library lending system designed to make the borrowing and reading of eBooks and Audio books enjoyable and the setup is simple to complete.

There is also a free ePlatform app, which can be downloaded through the Apple store, Google Play or the Windows app store. Students will need to log in and search for the Tarneit P-9 College library and then they will be able to access all our book titles.

ALL PARENTS- LIBRARY BAGS COMPULSORY for students in Prep to Grade 6

- All visitors must sign in and out of the College via the visitors' book, located at the office.
- Visitors will be given a lanyard to wear, indicating to staff and students that they are allowed to be in the school and at the Library.
- Volunteers with younger children are also welcome to help in the library.
