WOODWIND	Flute, Oboe, Clarinet, Bassoon, Saxophone (Alto, Tenor, Baritone).

Brass	Trumpet, French Horn, Trombone, Euphonium & Tuba.

#### Instruments

The following instruments are available for hire from the College at a fee of \$365.00 per year: Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass, Harp, Flute, Oboe, Clarinet, Bassoon, Saxophone, Trumpet, Trombone, Euphonium, Tuba, and French Horn.

Guitarists must purchase their own instrument.

Percussion students will pay a \$365.00 per year equipment maintenance fee.

Pipes and Drums students will pay a \$365.00 per year equipment maintenance fee.

#### **TUITION FEES**

## Strings/Woodwind/Brass/Percussion/Guitar

Individual 30 Minute lessons: \$1,490.00 per year.

#### Voice

Years 6-9 Individual 30 Minute lesson: \$1,490.00 per year Years 10-12 Individual 40 Minute lesson: \$1,990.00 per year

#### Piano

Individual 40 Minute lessons: \$1,990.00 per year

(All piano students)

#### Pipes & Drums

Shared 30 Minute lessons: \$745.00 per year.

Parents may request an individual 40-minute lesson for any instrument for the \$1,990.00 per year fee.

<u>YEAR 7:</u> Shared 30-minute lessons in Strings, Woodwind or Brass instruments at \$745.00 per year. Please note that shared lessons are only available if two boys of similar standard wish to learn the same instrument. Where this is not the case a student will automatically be enrolled in an individual lesson.

Most lessons occur during normal school hours and operate on a rotation basis. Some lessons can be fixed before school on request, but these places are strictly limited and offered to Year 11 and 12 students first. Other requests are subject to availability.

## **School Performing Groups**

The College has six main bands: Wind Orchestra, Wind Ensemble, Wind Band, Swing Bands I and II and the Pipes and Drums Band. There are three string groups: String Orchestra and String Ensembles I & II. Chamber ensembles in strings, woodwind, brass, percussion, and classical guitar compliment these larger groups. Contemporary rock bands complete the list of performing groups.

It is a requirement that a student will join the appropriate large ensemble once he has reached the required standard (see conditions of tuition).

Students who learn an instrument outside the College are welcome in the ensembles and should make themselves known to myself, so a place can be found for them.

Boys who wish to sing in either the year 7/8/9 Chorale, (Middle School Chorale) or the year 10/11/12 Chorale (Senior Chorale) may make a note of this on their instrumental application form. The Chorales perform as all male choirs and the senior boys also perform with the Mercedes College Select Choir.

All lessons commence in Week 2 of Term 1. Schedules will be visible on the students SEQTA timetable.

## **CONDITIONS OF TUITION**

Tuition should be undertaken for the entire academic year to guarantee the employment of hired teaching staff. Full annual tuition and hire fees are payable for withdrawals after Week 5 of Term 1. (Lesson 4)

If a student is unable to attend a lesson, he must inform the instrumental teacher prior to the day of his lesson to allow another lesson to be arranged. Due to the nature of the school's computerised attendance records, lessons cannot be changed on the day. If insufficient notice is given, the lesson may not be rescheduled.

Accurate records of practice and lesson attendance will be kept in the student Practice Record Book which must be brought, duly signed by parents, to all instrumental lessons. Practice Record books are provided by the College and given to the students at their first lesson.

Membership to the appropriate Instrumental Ensemble(s) becomes automatic when students reach the required standard. These include as a first priority; Wind Orchestra, Wind Ensemble, Wind Band, String Orchestra, String Ensemble I & II, Pipes and Drums Band, Swing Band I & Swing Band II. If a student is unable to attend rehearsals, parents are asked to notify the Performing Arts Department or ensemble director via email.

All instruments hired from the College become the student's responsibility. Students need to take all due care to maintain the instrument. Any negligent damage will be charged to the parents.
