
WHAT'S BEEN HAPPENING IN SENIOR SCHOOL?



In Content Knowledge students have begun learning about the Iliad. The Iliad is a Greek Mythology story that follows the events of the Trojan War and follows the Greek warrior Achilles. Students have been taking notes on important information from the reading and using these notes to answer Big Questions.

In Text Construction, students have been working on various sentence level strategy work. This includes combining simple sentences, expanding sentences, using appositives and including subordinating conjunctions. All of this work relates to the Iliad readings from Content Knowledge.

In Numeracy, students have been collecting data and estimating quantities/costs to host a hypothetical Taco Tuesday party. They used whole class data to establish generalisations of taco ingredients their peers like. Students then estimated costs, before actually calculating costs of taco ingredients.
