


Dear Parents and Carers,

As our Year 8 and 9 students have continued their remote and flexible learning, students have recently completed a range of assessment tasks across all subjects. In English, students in Year 8 are coming to the end of a unit of work on advertisement – its purpose, uses and impact on audiences. Students in Year 9 are currently completing their unit of work on persuasive writing – identifying and analysing persuasive writing and writing their own pieces using persuasive language.

In Mathematics, students in Year 8 have completed their measurement unit on congruence and have moved on to data. This has allowed students to explore different ways to collect data while learning remotely. In Year 9, students have just completed their assessment piece on measurement where they were asked to design a 3D layout of their bedroom and calculate features such as volume and surface area.
