Literacy & Numeracy Update

In Literacy, students have been learning many new digraphs to assist them in both their reading and writing. We have learnt /th/, /sh/, /ch/ and /ng/. In writing, students have enjoyed identifying the parts of a sentence and turning their fragments into a full sentence.

In Numeracy, we have enjoyed the Potato Olympics! Students were able to measure the distance their potato was able to roll, how heavy it was and also designed their countries flag.



Upcoming Focus

Over the next week, students will be learning the digraph sound /wh/ and explore the story Cinderella. In Numeracy they will continue to explore measurement, comparing the length, mass and capacity of different objects!

Skill in Focus

Capacity is described as how much a container can hold. This week we will be working with the students to challenge some common misconceptions about capacity. For example just because something is taller, doesn't necessarily mean it has a greater capacity. We will be measuring the capacity of various containers using sand and water.
