

Most of GAR's animals come from Death Row at Victorian Pounds.




The GAR Process

GAR has no shelter or office. GAR operates from the homes of its volunteers.



Incoming Statistics

GAR rescues at least one animal every second day.



GAR has rescued over 1400 animals.

The GAR Promise

GAR believes that physically healthy and behaviourally sound companion animals that are suitable for adoption should not be euthanised.

GAR has a general **no kill** policy unless advised that it is in the best interests of the animal to be euthanised by an expert such as:

- a veterinarian for medical pain and suffering or
- an animal behavourist for irreversible dangerous behaviour issues.

Behind the Scenes: GAR volunteers

It takes a lot of hands to keep GAR going!



GAR Board

6 volunteers who meet once a month to plan the everyday running and strategic direction of GAR.



Intake Team

Work with pounds, find a suitable GAR foster carer and arrange transport and paperwork.



Admin Team

Prepare, collect, complete, send, receive and file all of GAR's internal and external paperwork.



Foster Carers

Over 80+ foster carers at any one time, preparing and training animals for their forever homes.



Marketing Team

Prepare all of GAR's creative digital media, flyers, posters and forms.



Supplies Team

Source and store all animal food, flea and worm treatment and supplies such as beds, leads & collars.



Social Media Team

Post and respond to all social media and website queries 24/7.



Vet Team

Co-ordinate appointments, surgeries, medication and handle animal emergencies.



Fundraising Team

Brainstorm ideas. Organise resources and volunteers for events. Report to budget.



Induction Team

Recruit, train and provide support for new volunteers.



Donations Team

Collect , acknowledge and bank all donations. Issue receipts, manage locations and database.



Photographers

Photograph animals for website and social media to give animals the best chance of adoption.
