Every student and member of the Marist College Ashgrove community has a right to feel safe and respected. The College has in place a number of Policies and Procedures to facilitate this aim. These policies include:

- (a) Safe School Policy
  - (b) Student Management Procedures and Policy (c) Child Protection Policy
- (d) Harassment Policy (e) Bullying Policy

If you feel that you are not safe or are suffering due to discrimination or bullying you are encouraged to take action.

ARE YOU BEING BULLIED OR **DISCRIMINATED** AGAINST? YOU CAN CONTROL WHAT HAPPENS!

**DON'T RETALIATE** EITHER PHYSICALLY OR VERBALLY.

Show it doesn't upset you - ignore it

If the harassment stops no more action is needed

Speak to the person harassing you. Tell them the behaviour is unwanted and illegal.

If the harassment stops no more action is needed

Tell someone - this is not "dobbing". Talk it over with:

- Your Pastoral Group teacher or **Boarding Supervisor**
- School Counsellors
- A senior student

- Any member of staff with whom you feel comfortable
