Dear Parent / Guardians

Greenvale Primary School is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of Greenvale's parent payment arrangements for 2021. Greenvale Primary School has taken into consideration the unusual Covid19 circumstances and have decided to reduce the 2021 parent payments. This reduction will only be for the 2021 parent payments and full fees will be considered for 2022.

Please find the fee schedule for Foundation students attached. Please make arrangements by 9th December, 2020 so the school can prepare accordingly.

Greenvale Primary School makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents.

Each year the School Council has the role of approving the school budget based upon the goals and priorities as outlined in the school strategic plan. The School Council has three major sources of funding: the Student Resource Package paid by the Department of Education & Training (DET), family payments for materials/programs and local fundraising. The Department's Student Resource Package meets most of the costs related to salaries, administration and operational costs such as heating and cleaning. However, it does not meet the cost of individual student packs, classroom packs and consumables associated with some specialists programs. At Greenvale Primary School we will always make every effort to keep the cost and number of items that are needed to be purchased to a minimum. We will also try to ensure that the costs are affordable for all parents.

PARENT PAYMENTS POLICY

ONE PAGE OVERVIEW

The following is a summary of the main principles of the Parent Payments Policy:



FREE INSTRUCTION

- Schools provide students with free instruction to fulfil the standard curriculum requirements as outlined in the Victorian Curriculum F-10, VCE and VCAL.



PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

- Schools do not ask parents to pay for school operating costs (e.g. utility costs) or general and unspecified charges.
- Schools request payments from parents under three categories:

Essential Student Learning Items

- Items and activities which the school deems essential for student learning.
- Parents may choose to purchase essential items through the school or provide their own.

Optional Items

- Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are offered in addition to the standard curriculum.
- These are provided to students on a user-pays basis.

Voluntary Contributions

- Voluntary contributions support the school to continue to be the best local school for all students and can be for general or specific purpose.
- Students will not be disadvantaged in any way if parents do not make a contribution.



FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

- Schools put in place financial hardship arrangements to support families who cannot pay for items or activities so that their child doesn't miss out.
- Schools have a nominated parent payment contact person(s) that parents can have a confidential discussion with regarding financial hardship arrangements.



SCHOOL PROCESSES

- Schools obtain school council approval for their parent payment arrangements and upload their arrangements on their school's public website for transparency.
