We have designed a user-friendly way for schools to communicate with parents with ease. Our portal gives parents access to a platform that will contain everything they need in one place.

What we include

Our portal includes various modules for schools to utilize. Through these modules, you will have the ability to do a multitude of things all in one place without the need for logging into various programs.

Our portal includes:

- Dashboard get an overview of your child's performance, submit absence details and access Student Reports on the go
- Notices stay up-to-date with school activities and news
- Forms provide parental consent to various school activities and events
- NMeet book your Parent Teacher conference meeting online with ease
- Calendar see ahead of time what is planned for the school year
- Medical view and revise your child's medical records
- First Aid stay informed on any first-aid incidents that occur while at school

Getting started


Logging in

When logging in, you will see multiple options on how to login. You can login either with a google account or another preferred email address. The most important thing to note is that it must be the email registered with the school.

For example, if you have two emails, one Google and one Hotmail, and the Hotmail is linked to the school, logging in through the google option with your Gmail account, will not work.

To log into the nPortal use this link: https://portal.nforma.com.au/login

To setup your password for the first time, you will need to click on the "Forgot Password" link. From there, enter the email address registered to the school. Once done, you should receive an email with a password reset. Once you have updated your password, you can then login.





From here, you can also send absence information to the school if your child is going to be away from school. This will help the school save time in marking absences as the data will be transferred straight into the school's system.


You will also be able to access the medical module through the child's profile.

Keeping you up to date



Your Permission



School dates


With our parent portal, schools can have either their current google calendar linked to the portal or a separate portal calendar. Regardless of what they choose, you can always view upcoming school events.

Setting up a meeting



Ensure to always read the name of the meeting in case the nMeet has multiple days options.




Medical

Health and safety

Our medical module is a great way for you to keep schools up to date with your child's health conditions and medical history. The module acts as an interface where you and the school can upload any health-related data. Whether it be names of doctors to current medication the child is prescribed to, everything will be found there.





First Aid

Keeping you informed

First aid is a great way for the school to keep you informed of any visits your child may have to the first aid bay. Our program allows the first aid staff to give you reports of what has happened and any further actions required, ensuring you are always up to date on the safety of your child. You can access the report in the medical module or it may be sent to you via email.
