## 7/3 Day 2 - Tokyo Sky Tree Tower

The Tokyo Skytree (東京スカイツリー) is a television broadcasting tower and landmark of Tokyo. It is the centerpiece of the Tokyo Sky Tree Town in the Sumida City Ward, not far away from Asakusa. With a height of 634 meters, it is the tallest structure in Japan and was the second tallest in the world at the time of its completion. A large shopping complex with an aquarium is located at its base.

#### 宿泊室

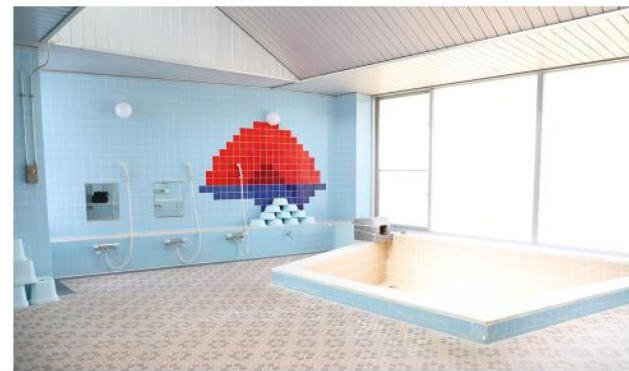
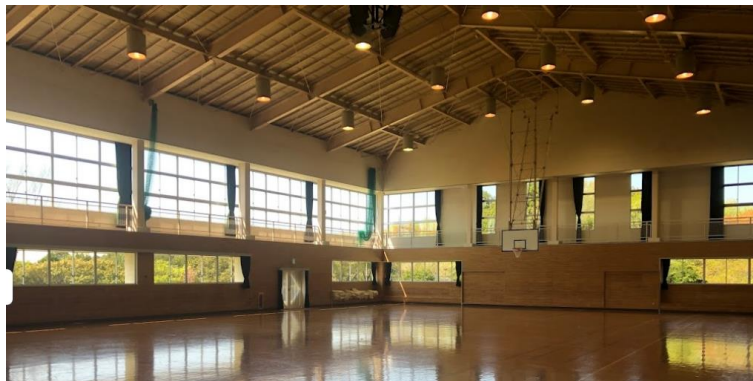

Cooperated with Edosaki Area government, our students will be participating in the Gion Matsuri 2024.

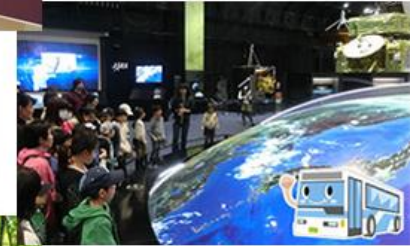
This day, our student will be trained by the locals, with the locals together, for the dance and what to do on the Matsuri weekend.

### 畳づくり体験 or Taiko Experience

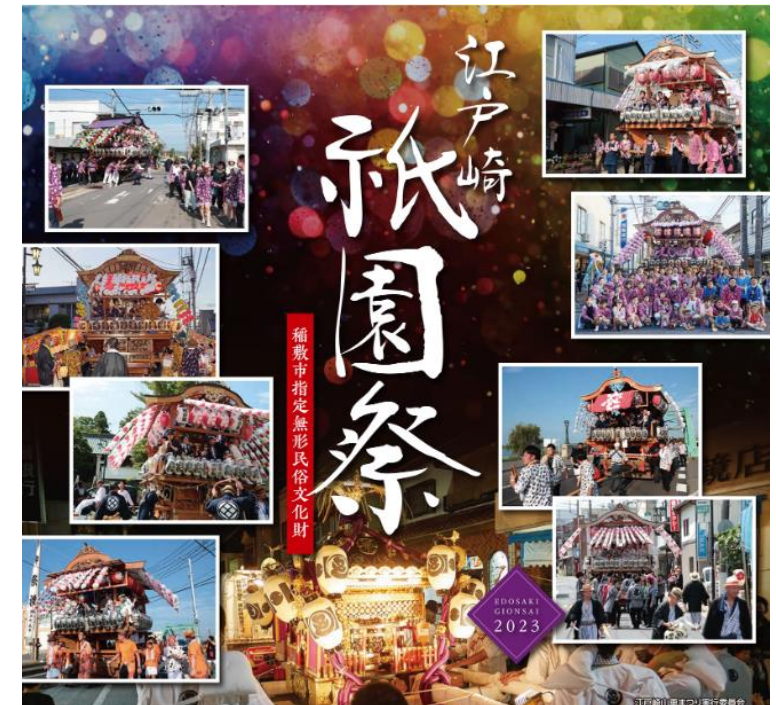
Meet the Traditional Tatami professionals in person, see how tatami is produced and make your own mini Tatami as souvenir to your own country.
