

2025 Term 4 Parent Overview



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Religion

This term in Religion, students will be exploring the role of Mary, Mother of God, as a model of faith, love, and compassion in our lives. They will also reflect on the messages within our school song and deepen their understanding of the season of Advent and the Christmas story, focusing on the significance of Christ's birth and the ways we can offer our own gifts of love and kindness to Jesus.

Wellbeing

This term in Wellbeing, students will explore resilience and what it means to develop a growth mindset. Through our *Respectful Relationships* units, they will also examine positive gender relationships and gender norms. In addition, students will take part in their *Inform and Empower* session, where they'll build skills in critical thinking, digital literacy, and learn how to be kind and responsible digital citizens.

English

This term in English, students will be learning about persuasive writing and the language techniques used to convince a reader of their opinion. They will choose a familiar topic that interests them, plan their ideas, and craft a persuasive piece of writing. Students will also explore how letters can be used to persuade others effectively. Throughout the unit, they will focus on constructing simple and compound sentences, paying close attention to sentence structure, punctuation, and grammar. In addition, students will engage with a variety of texts to deepen their understanding of how writers use language and ideas to influence their audience.

Maths

This term in Mathematics, in Location, they will explore how to give and follow directions using everyday language and simple maps to describe where objects and places are found.

Through Fractions, students will learn to recognise and represent equal parts of a whole using shapes, objects, and everyday examples such as sharing food or dividing collections.

In Measurement, the focus will be on Mass and Capacity, where students will compare, order, and measure how heavy or full different objects and containers are using informal and formal units.

Students will also investigate Patterns, identifying, creating, and continuing number and shape patterns to develop their problem-solving and reasoning skills.

Inquiry

This term in Inquiry, students will be learning all about Biology. They'll explore the amazing world of animals and plants, discovering what living things need to survive, grow, and stay healthy. Through fun, hands-on activities, students will choose an animal to research and create a project that shows what they've learned about how it lives and thrives.
