Students gain exposure to the inner workings of various sports business teams such as cricket operations, fan engagement, membership operations, community engagement, marketing, media/communications, events, clinics and more. Entry requirements are successful completion of an Australian Year 12 or equivalent certificate (including VCE or VCE VM).

Students who are keen on continuing with further study, will have one year guaranteed credit given towards the RMIT Bachelor of Business Degree (so only two more years to complete).
