***Any person showing signs and symptoms of COVID-19 must not attend venues/courts and must seek medical advice. This MUST be adhered to by players, coaches, parents and siblings.***

### Attendance

Only the following people will be permitted in the playing venue / courtside:-

- Players
- Coaches
- Sport Staff/TIC of Basketball
- Officials (incl. COVID Managers), Referees
- Medical Staff

### Facilities

- A canteen WILL NOT be in operation at most venues on game day.
- Toilets will be available. Please ensure good hygiene practices are adhered too.
- There will be no changerooms available. Players are to arrive in playing gear.
- Hand sanitiser will be made available to both schools' benches during play
- No Dogs / Pets are permitted
- QR code check in will be in operation upon entry for all spectators

### Player Information

- Please arrive in playing uniform, ready to warm up and play.
- Personal hand sanitiser should be used
- No shaking hands with opposition or teammates. No sharing of equipment (Eg, towels)
- Bring your own filled water bottles, enough to last the entirety of your training/game, clearly marked with your name. **DO NOT SHARE WATER BOTTLES**
- First aid will be available on the day
- NO SPITTING

Upon the completion of your fixture/training, we ask that staff and students adhere to social distancing practices. When convenient at the conclusion of the match, please move offsite as soon as possible.

### COVID Guidelines and Protocols for Northern Beaches Indoor Sports Centre

#### **Current rules in place for NBISC**

- Matches are 2 x 20-minute running clock halves no stoppages for time outs/2 min halftime.
- Players to leave through exit doors so the new group can enter.
- Entry through front doors only.
- Participants to QR scan and sanitise on entry.
- All participants 16 and over are to show proof of double vaccination.  
To gain entry.
- 25 maximum per court. No spectators.
- Saints will supply one bench person to do the scoreboard we won't be using scoresheets due to the restriction in numbers.
