

This scholarship covers:

- Potential opportunities for mentorship by experienced professional engineers, providing insights, knowledge and expertise that will be valuable in establishing your engineering career.

Eligibility

This scholarship is open to students currently in Year 12 intending to study an ECU Engineering Bachelor course* in 2027.

You must also:

- Be an Australian or New Zealand citizen, permanent resident, or the holder of a refugee or humanitarian visa.
- Be completing Year 12 studies (WACE or an equivalent program) in the year you apply.
- Satisfy admission requirements for your intended ECU Engineering Bachelor course.
- Not be in receipt of any other merit-based scholarship at ECU.
- Plan to be a full-time student studying on-campus at ECU Joondalup.

*Non eligible courses are: Bachelor of Technology (Aeronautical); Bachelor of Engineering Honours/Bachelor of Commerce; Bachelor of Engineering Honours/Bachelor of Science; and Bachelor of Engineering (Computer Systems) Honours/Bachelor of Computer Science.
