Dear Parents & Carers,

We are excited about our school swimming carnival being held on **Thursday 5th February 2026**.

Students in Years 2 - 6 will be participating in the carnival commencing earlier. These students will receive a different note.

Kindergarten and Year 1 students will visit the pool for novelty games from 11:30am - 1:00pm.

**In the case of inclement weather, only our older competitive swimmers will attend the pool on this day for formal events and other students will attend at a later date.**

**Time:** 11:30am - 1:00pm

**Where:** Tenterfield Memorial Baths

**Cost:** No cost thanks to a Donation from Tenterfield Aquatic Centre. We do need to know your Season Ticket number if you do have one.

**What to pack:** water bottles, sunscreen, towel, hat, slides or little thongs for their feet (ensure every item has your child's name on it).

**What to wear:**

- Students can wear either their full school sports uniform OR clothes of their House Colour (Penola = RED, Mackillop = BLUE) Ensure EVERY item has your child's name on it
- Students should wear their swimmers to school under their clothing, and bring dry clothes to change into following their swim - please don't forget their undies!
- **For sun safety - every student must wear a rash shirt or a t-shirt.**

**Organisation:**

Students will complete their morning session at school, including recess, which will be a little earlier to allow them to eat and get ready. They will depart by bus at 11:15am for the pool and then have some fun with novelty activities and have some time to cheer on their friends in the competitive events.

Please note there is **NO SCHOOL CANTEEN ON THIS DAY**. Students are required to bring a packed recess and lunch.
