Dear Parents/Caregivers of students in Year 6

Annual Speech Night

The Clayfield College Annual Speech Night is on Tuesday 14 November at 7pm in the Concert Hall at the Queensland Performing Arts Centre (QPAC). The performance is expected to end at approximately 9.30pm. Year 6 students who are continuing their education at the College are expected to attend, as they will be presented on stage with their Year 7 Badge. Students are to wear their full winter uniform (no hats). The evening is a wonderful expression of the College community, providing an opportunity for students to develop dispositions associated with well-being and success.

Year 6 students (including choristers and instrumentalists) are required to be at the QPAC Concert Hall during the day on Tuesday 14 November to rehearse for the event. Details relating to the organisation of this are outlined below.

8:15am	Assemble in Amphitheatre for roll call by Mrs Bryan
8:30am	Depart from Clayfield College by bus
9.00am	Rehearsal of the Year 6 section of the program with Mrs Fellowes
11:00am	Year 6 students who are not musicians return to school by bus Remain at school for the rest of the school day
11.30am	Year 6 musicians who are not continuing into Year 7 at Clayfield College will depart by bus from Clayfield College for the afternoon's music rehearsal at QPAC
11:30am – 12.15pm	Musicians remain at QPAC. (Bring your own packed lunch.)
12.15pm – 5.00pm	Rehearsal of musical items
5.00pm – 6.00pm	All musicians may pre-order a meal from QPAC. This pre-ordered dinner (\$18.00) may be purchased online using this link (closes Monday 6/11): https://events.humanitix.com/2023-speech-night-musician-meal-selection
6:00pm	Tune and Warm Up for instrumentalists
6:20pm	Choristers to their seats on stage
6:30pm	All Year 6s who are not musicians should meet Mrs Bryan outside Door 8 to collect their tickets. Each student has a seat allocated in the auditorium with their year group and supervised by Mrs Bryan.

Uniform Requirements Speech Night

Please be advised of the uniform requirements for Speech Night; a formal event of the College.

<u>Year 7 Girls</u>

All in new uniform- navy skirt or trousers; white, long sleeve shirt; winter tie; navy stockings or navy socks if wearing trousers; blazer; blazer; black school shoes; hair off collar with a green ribbon; bow or scrunchie. Hats not required.

Year 8-12 Girls

New uniform- navy skirt or trousers; white, long sleeve shirt; winter tie; navy stockings or navy socks if wearing trousers; blazer; black school shoes; hair off collar with a green ribbon; bow or scrunchie **OR** green/white striped dress; blazer; white, short socks; black school shoes; hair off collar with a green ribbon; bow or scrunchie. Hats not required.

<u>Year 7 Boys</u>

Navy trousers; white, long sleeve shirt; winter tie; navy socks, blazer, black school shoes; hair off collar with green elastic. Hats not required.

<u>Year 6 Girls</u>

Green/white, striped dress <u>OR</u> green/white, striped shirt; navy skort; white, short socks; black school shoes; hair off collar with a green ribbon; bow or scrunchie. Hats not required.

Year 6 Boys

Navy shorts; striped, green shirt <u>OR</u> plain green shirt; navy, short socks; black school shoes; hair off collar with green elastic. Hats not required.

There is to be no jewellery worn except for a watch, earrings (gold/silver studs/sleepers, small white pearls). No spray tans, false eyelashes or nails, and no make-up.

School shoes must be polished.

Badges are to be worn on the lapels of the blazer.

This a compulsory event, and every student is expected to adhere to these guidelines. If you are a prize winner or musician, you will not be permitted on stage unless all above guidelines are followed.
