



# NATIONAL CHRISTIAN SCHOOLS SPORTS

Since 2001, secondary school students have had the opportunity to represent Victoria in a variety of sports. In 2018, students can trial for one of the following sports for the 2019 NCSS – Basketball, Netball, Soccer or Tennis.

Qualification:

Any student that is enrolled at a CSEN Member School is eligible to nominate for trials.  
All teams will be U/16 age groups (born 2003 or later).

At this stage, Victoria will look to send the following teams:

- 2 x Boys Basketball (maximum of 10 players per team)
- 1 x Boys Soccer (maximum of 15 players)
- 1 x Boys Tennis (maximum of 5 players)
- 2 x Girls Basketball (maximum of 10 players per team)
- 2 x Girls Netball (maximum of 10 players per team)
- 1 x Girls Soccer (maximum of 15 players)
- 1 x Girls Tennis (maximum of 5 players)

Trial Days:

Monday 27<sup>th</sup> August  
10:00am – 2:00pm

Friday 14<sup>th</sup> September  
10:00am – 2:00pm

After the first trial day, some students will be asked to attend the second date. Students from Ballarat, Covenant, Creek Street, Kerang, Kings, River City and Victory are only required to attend the second trial date.

Trial Venues:

Basketball and Netball – State Basketball Centre, George Street, Wantirna South  
Soccer – Knox Regional Football Centre, George Street, Wantirna South  
Tennis – Pakenham Regional Tennis Centre, Webster Way, Pakenham

Training:

Maximum of 6 sessions (2 compulsory sessions) between February 2019 and May 2019.  
A variety of venues / days will be used, depending on the students selected in the team.  
All trainings will be after school.

NCSS:

Monday 20<sup>th</sup> May 2019 – Friday 24<sup>th</sup> May 2019 (Gold Coast, Queensland)

Uniform:

CSEN will supply playing shirts for Basketball, Soccer and Tennis, as well as Dresses for Netball.  
Students will be expected to purchase CSEN playing shorts, socks, travel jumper, travel polo and travel shorts.

Expected Costs:

\$25.00 for trial days – invoiced to school  
Not more than \$1500.00 for NCSS, plus uniform (this includes all costs, other than 3 x meals while travelling).
