



Year 10 Multi-Industry Pathway Program

AGA's Year 10 Multi-Industry Pathway Program provides an opportunity for eligible secondary school students to get a hands on experience to understand what working in each trade is like and gain some skills and see what suits them.

This helps students to make an informed decision about their Yr 11 and 12 program choices and potential future career path.

The 6-month program, centred on a hands-on construction project, guides them through the stages of a Basic Construction Job. Students will gain practical experience while building key competencies such as Teamwork, Work Health and Safety (WHS), estimation, and technical trade skills.

Throughout the semester, the program will have designated sessions where the students explore the different industries in detail and overviews of the Certificate II pre-apprenticeships, and examples of future roles of fully qualified trades people in the future.
