# Information and Booking Details.

## Booking Information

### Bookings open:

**5 pm, Friday 14 February 2020.**

**Bookings close:** Booking remains open until it reaches full capacity.

**Please note:** Only ONE venue can be selected for you child/children to attend.

**Please note:** Due to the high demand for places, please submit your

applications as soon as the booking period commences.

## Priority of Access and completing your booking

- To be eligible your child/children must be attending a primary school.
- Families working, living or studying in Moreland will be given priority.

By submitting your enrolment, your place is not guaranteed. Bookings will be processed in date order.

We aim to notify families regarding bookings open dates however it is highly recommended that families have their own reminder systems in place

Child Care Subsidy Scheme (CCSS): Please ensure that you are registered with "MY GOV" [my.gov.au](http://my.gov.au) to be able to claim the childcare subsidy (CCS) otherwise you will be charged full fees.

## Step 1 Book online at [moreland.vic.gov.au](http://moreland.vic.gov.au)

## Step 2 Confirmation of places

Once your booking is confirmed you will receive a Statement of Entitlement that includes BPAY details. Payments and cancellations: must be received by Friday 13 March 2020.

**If you do not receive notification by Wednesday 11 March 2020 please call the School Holiday Program Officer on 9240 2427 or on 9240 2360 or email [schoolholidayprogram@moreland.vic.gov.au](mailto:schoolholidayprogram@moreland.vic.gov.au) Otherwise you will be liable for all days booked.**

- For cancellations received after Friday 13 March 2020, full fees must be paid regardless of whether your child attends or not
- If your child is absent, it will be recorded as an absence with the Childcare Subsidy provider (fees still payable).
- If you are on a waiting list: You will be contacted by phone and/or email if a place becomes available.
- First day absences: For each program if your child is absent on your first booked day, you are not eligible for CCS and full fees will apply on all absences until the first day of the child's attendance.
- Last day absences: For each program CCS will apply up to the last day of attendance. If your child is absent up to and including the last day of your booking, you are not eligible for CCS and full fees will apply for these absences.

## Step 3 Payment

Cost per child per day is \$83 for up to 10 hours of care, less Child Care Subsidy (CCS) (if you are eligible or registered).

Payment must be received by due date above, please contact Council if you require a payment extension.

- **Direct Debit** from an account with a financial institute (a Direct Debit Request form must be completed and returned at least one week prior to payment due date).
- **B-Pay** using an account with a financial institute or credit card.
- **B-Pay Biller Code** 275776.

The activity details for each day of the program are just a guide.

Activities undertaken during each day depend on children's interests, weather or what is happening on that particular day.

All information at the time of printing in this brochure, is true and correct but can be subject to change without notice.

# Information and Booking Details.

## Venue Opening Hours

- All venues are open from 8 am to 6 pm.
- Staff are unable to accept children before 8.00 am.
- If your child/children is attending an excursion, please ensure he/she is dropped off at the requested time to avoid any inconvenience.
- **Parents cannot drop off/pick up their child/children from excursion locations for security reasons.**

## Medical Information

- If your child has any allergies/sensitivities or a medical condition (e.g. anaphylaxis, asthma, diabetes, epilepsy) you must provide (if not already submitted) a relevant medical plan.
- If the required information is not provided to us, your application cannot be processed and will be sent back to you.
- Each venue will complete an annual anaphylaxis risk minimisation/communication plan and/or a checklist with the parent/authorised nominee at the beginning of each program and when required.
- The plans will be kept on file and will be updated as required.

## Healthy Lunches

- Please ensure that you pack plenty of healthy food for your child/children.
- Children are required to bring healthy snacks and drinks (no soft drinks please) every day.
- Healthy lunchbox idea sheets are available for parents at each program.
- Our venues do not have facilities for heating or preparing children's lunches.
- We have limited access to refrigeration – **for medication only.**
- On some occasions children may have a cooking experience as part of an activity on that day.

## Valuables

- Children should not bring valuable items to the program i.e. money, mobile phones, iPods/iPads or any electronic devices that can access the internet.
- Children have the opportunity to bring small hand-held games that can be periodically used during the day under staff supervision.
- Moreland City Council and staff will not be held responsible should any valuables be stolen, lost or damaged.

## Cancellations

- If you wish to cancel your bookings, notification must be received in writing by emailing **schoolholidayprogram@moreland.vic.gov.au** by **5 pm Friday 13 March 2020.**
- If a cancellation is not received by this date you will be required to pay for all bookings made, whether your child attends or not.

## Transport / Excursion days

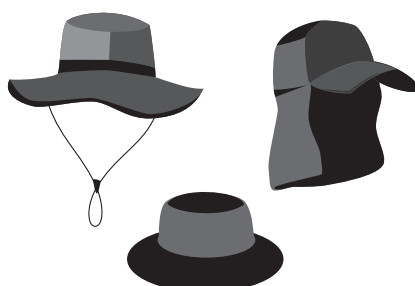
