We have taken the next step in ensuring that our service is providing an above and beyond safe environment for your children by appointing an Enrolled Nurse at our service.

This enrolled nurse will be delegated the title Early Childhood Nurse and will be present at the service Monday through to Friday from 9am -3pm.

This will be a non contact role and duties of the ECN would be:

- ✓ Facilitation and intake of medical action plans
 - ✓ Administration of medication
 - ✓ Assessment of sick children
- ✓ Provide care for sick children until they are collected from our service
- ✓ Work with local GP's and EC Health centres
 - ✓ NDIS applications and support work
 - ✓ Children's developmental milestones
 - ✓ Parents Evaluation Tool support
 - ✓ First Aid & first in scene for injuries.

It is important to point out that the ECN is not appointed to care for children who are sick for session times and our Collection Of Sick Children policy still applies. You must still collect your child if they become sick or injured while in our care.

Fees & Child Care Subsidy

All families are entitled to a certain CCS percentage and benefit hours that the government pays directly to the centre as financial relief towards family's fees. To enquire about your CCS percentage and hours, please contact the Family Assistance Office on 13 61 50.

Below is a table to indicate our daily fees prior to any CCS relief. We also offer session times to accommodate for the new fortnightly hour system.

QLD Government Kindergarten Approved Program

Plainland Kindergarten & Child Care delivers a QLD Government Approved Kindergarten Program to children who are about to commence prep. This program runs from 9am-5pm weekdays and is delivered by our qualified Early Childhood-Primary School Teacher who holds a Bachelor of Education. This curriculum prepares children for a school environment and provides them with a standard of education that will give them a flying head start.
