### Parent Payment Plan

Approximately \$9,250 is the expected tour cost depending on the number of students involved.

We will be using a payment plan to ensure all deposit requirements to World Projects are met throughout the lead up to the tour. Payments will be structured to occur in Term 4, 2022, Term 1 and Term 2 in 2023. Should you wish to pay the entire amount ahead of time, you are more than welcome. The payment plan will be emailed home once the tour has been confirmed.

### Music Tour Contract

All Clayfield touring ensembles and choirs have necessary expectations and have been set out to ensure that the Clayfield Music Department upholds its high level of performance when representing the school at an international level.

If students fail to fulfil the expectations their place on the tour may be jeopardised.

### Music Tour Contract

- Attend all weekly rehearsals on the designated day and time for each ensemble/choir they are touring with.
- Come to all rehearsals prepared with individual parts rehearsed at home each week.
- Attend any extra rehearsals that will be called prior to the tour (there will be approximately 2 per ensemble).
- Attend the compulsory tour concert.
- Submit a note to the Director explaining any absences.
- Participate enthusiastically in all rehearsals and performances.
- Follow all directions given by staff.

### Student Travel Information

- Maximum 60 students
- 1 to 10 staff ratio
- All staff have CPR and first aid training
- Prior to travel -
  - Signed student camp/vacation trip consent form
  - Medical clearance letter (updated medical details)
  - Current passport
