



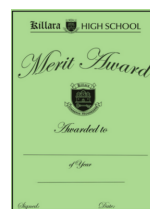

Merit Award

1 Merit Point

Awarded by teachers based on a student upholding the school values; respect, ownership, learner, environment. This is a digital merit on Compass.



Faculty Merit

5 Merit Points

Nominated by classroom teachers and approved by Head Teachers for outstanding achievement at faculty level.



Extra-Curricular Merit

5 Merit Points

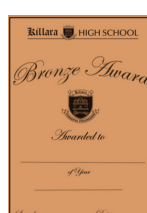
Nominated by the coordinating teacher of an extra-curricular activity based on effort, application and achievement.



Bronze Award

10 Merit Points

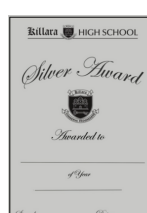
Awarded to students who have received 10 merit points. Students are awarded a digital Bronze as well as a physical award in Home Group.



Silver Award

3 Bronze Awards

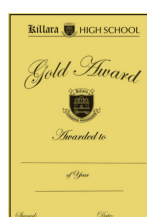
Awarded to students who have received 3 Bronze Awards. Students are awarded a digital Silver as well as a physical award at a Year Meeting.



Gold Award

2 Silver Awards

Awarded to students who have received 2 Silver Awards. Students are awarded a digital Gold as well as a physical award at a Stage Assembly.



Honour Badge

1 Gold plus 1 Silver Award

Awarded to students who have received 1 Gold plus an additional Silver Award. Students are awarded a digital Honour Badge as well as a physical award in a Stage Assembly or Whole School Assembly.



Honour Pennant

4 Honour Badges

Awarded to students who have received 4 Honour Badges across their school career. Presented at the end of year Awards Ceremony or Ekuba.



Honour Blue

6 Honour Badges

Awarded to students who have received 6 Honour Badges across their school career. Presented at the end of year Awards Ceremony or Ekuba.



Honour Platinum

7 Honour Badges

The schools most prestigious award. Awarded to students who have received 7 Honour Badges across their school career. Presented at the end of year Awards Ceremony or Ekuba.



Each student's merit awards are carried on from one year to the next with the goal to recognise every students' achievements over time.

All merit awards are centrally recorded on Compass and should be given by teachers regularly and equitably

Students individual merit points will also contribute to their House points total helping their House to win the annual House Cup.
