Students attend sessions on Fridays beginning in the second week of school term. Through analysing written material and writing reports and essays students develop scientific comprehension and critical thinking skills for present and future studies.

Places are limited. Enrollments are required as soon as possible. Course will only run if sufficient students enrol by the Friday of Week 2.
