Secretary

 Responsible for ensuring the smooth execution for running the monthly meetings of the PFA, including: preparation and distribution of the Agenda; taking minutes at PFA meetings, and distributing minutes to the committee members and other relevant parties.

Treasurer

Responsible for collating and keeping correct account records of the PFA, including; collecting and receiving all moneys due to the PFA and making authorised payments; keeping accurate and up to date accounts and records of the financial affairs of the PFA; and preparation of a Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Statement to share at each PFA monthly meeting and the Annual General Meeting.

Class Rep Co-ordinator/s

- Recruit class reps for each grade and communicate relevant information to class reps to be shared with parents.
- Oversee and assist Class Rep run activities for the year (each grade is allocated an event per year, e.g. Mother's and Father's Day stalls)

Tuck Shop Co-ordinator

- Prepares rosters at the beginning of each term and Tuckshop price lists.
- o Ensures tuckshop food items are stocked and maintained.
- o Reports to the council inspector as required.

Foodbank Co-ordinator

- The OHR Foodbank is a roster of parents who are willing to be called upon to provide a meal for school families during a time of need (e.g following the birth of a baby or during a time of illness or bereavement).
- The Co-ordinator organises meal rosters and acts as a trusted and confidential contact.

Each of the above roles may be shared between more than one parent.
