2026 | Years 1 to 5 Device Overnight Waiver

Dear Parents and Caregivers

For students in the Lower Junior School, we understand that laptops and iPads contribute significantly to the weight of school bags. Other families find the device a distraction at home and would prefer staff to control the use of them throughout the week. With this considered, and to support families, the College has lockable trolleys for student devices in Years 1 to 5. As the devices are your property it is still the College's recommendation that devices be taken to and from school every afternoon.

Parent Action Required - Instructions:

- ***Log into Parent Lounge***
- ***Home Icon Menu / Event & Payment Tab (column on left)***
- ***Select – 2026 Junior Years 1-5 Overnight Device Waiver***
- ***Under 'Registration' on the right side, select Accept to view the Terms and Conditions document***
- ***Please review the 2026 Junior Years 1-5 Overnight Device Waiver and then select the check box and press Save.***

By accepting, you agree to the following:

- I agree to waive any liability for damage or theft of my personal electronic device if I choose to leave it overnight at Clayfield College.
- I will supply another charger (charging plug and cable clearly named) for the device, which will be kept in the trolley and remain at school, for ease of charging and use.
- Staff will lock the trolley at 3:10pm every afternoon and over the weekend. If a student requires their device, it is their responsibility to take it home.

Devices are not permitted to be left overnight at the College without your acceptance in Parent Lounge of this agreement.
