<p>Background information about Yarrabah School</p>	<p>Yarrabah is a Specialist School that caters for students with intellectual, physical and/or multiple disabilities in the bayside suburb of Aspendale, aged between 2.8 and 18 years.</p> <p>Yarrabah's purpose is to maximise student potential by providing an individualised safe learning environment that promotes active learning, encourages adventure, independence and self-esteem. Yarrabah provides all students an individualised curriculum with therapeutic supports that prepare them for life as valued members of the community.</p>
