2025 Important Information

- School commences for Year 1-6 students on Monday 10th February 2024 (staff will return on Thursday 6th February). Kindergarten students will start on Wednesday 12th February 2025.
- Some other schools in Narrabri may have different start dates for Kinder.
- Kindergarten children will be allocated a time to sit the Best Start
 Assessment on either Monday 10th or Tuesday 11th February. All
 students in NSW complete this assessment and parents will receive a
 report afterwards. There is nothing you need to do in preparation for the
 assessment.





- 2025 staffing hasn't yet been finalised, but communication will come out later this term regarding who the 2025 Kindergarten teachers will be.
- We will be having a New Class Session towards the end of this term.
 All 2025 Kindergarten students will be invited to this session so they can meet their teachers for next year.

First Day of 'Big' School



- School bag packed with;
 - o Fruit, pre-cut where necessary, in a separate container for easy access at Crunch 'n' Sip time
 - Lunchbox packed with recess and lunch
 - Water Bottle
 - School Hat, labelled with your child's name
- Normal school uniform (sports uniform on Wednesdays and Fridays)
- No books or pencil cases are necessary in Kindergarten
- It's a good idea for your child to pack a small packet of tissues and hand sanitizer
- No toys or sports equipment needed unless for News Day





Routines and Habits

- Ensure your child recognises their own name (being able to write their name is also great before school starts, but not essential)
- Practice school readiness habits such as packing and zipping up school bags, packing up lunch boxes and washing hands thoroughly with soap and water
- Practice tying shoelaces or invest in shoes that do not need to be tied!





Routines and Habits

- Provide opportunities for manageable independence. This might include:
 - Getting their own drink of water
 - Make a simple snack for themselves
 - Open and close lunch boxes and containers
 - Picking up after themselves (toys, pencils, etc)
 - Walking to and from places when safe
 - Following two-step instructions
 - Carrying their own bag
 - Opening food packets





Fine Motor Skills

- Use a peg to help strengthen pencil grip (Birdy Beak)
- Squishy or bouncy balls squeezed in the hands to strengthen grip
- Practice tracing their name
- Bead threading
- Pick up small objects with tweezers





Gross Motor Skills

- Jumping with two feet together e.g. kangaroo bounds
- Hop
- Walking forwards and backwards
- Frog jumps
- Crab walks
- Wall push-ups
- Planks
- Throwing and catching a ball





Medical Professionals

- Vision assessment (ask about bulk billing option)
- Hearing assessment (ask about bulk billing option)
- Speech Therapy assessment (if notified by the school or doctor)
- Occupational Therapy assessment (if notified by the school or doctor)

Important things to remember!



- School life is a marathon, not a sprint.
- Transition to Kindergarten can be very challenging physically and mentally for both your child and for yourself.
- Never compare your child to another child even their siblings!
