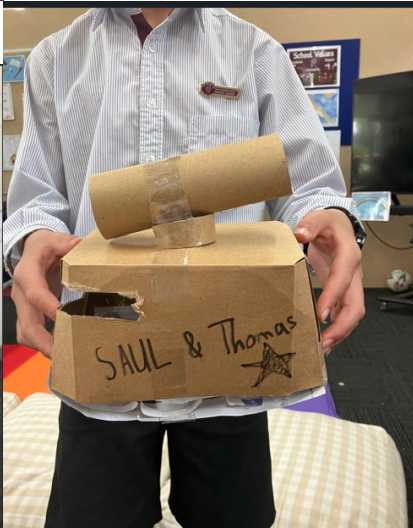
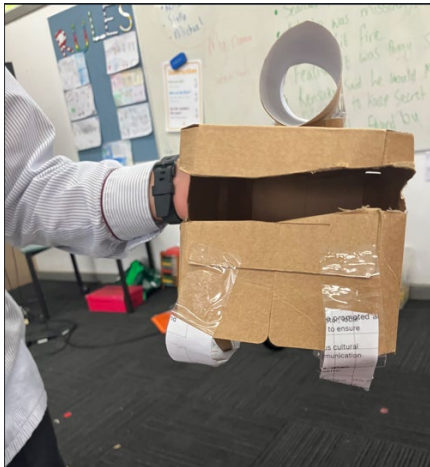
I'm really looking forward to another great term filled with fun, creativity, and lots of learning (and a bit of chaos too 😊).
