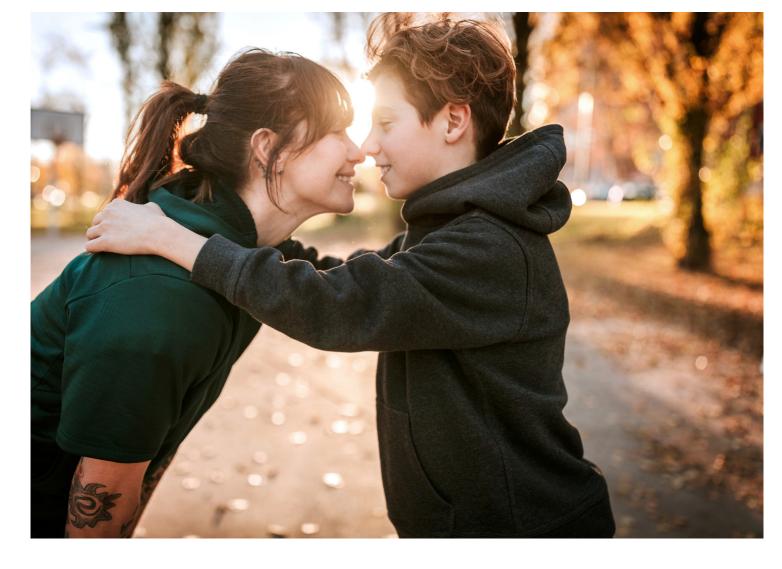
ParentZone aims to cater to all ages and stages, from newborns to teenagers with a range of topics and information to assist in the many complexities families can bring.

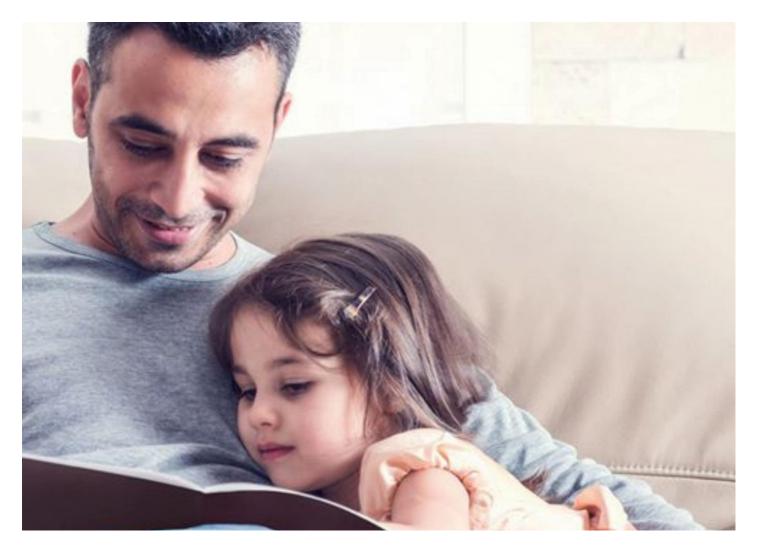

- Teachable Moments
