WHAT IS ANZAC DAY?

ANZAC DAY IS ONE OF ANZAC AUSTRALIA'S MOST IMPORTANT NATIONAL COMMEMORATIVE **OCCASIONS. IT MARKS THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE FIRST** MAJOR MILITARY ACTION FOUGHT BY AUSTRALIAN AND NEW ZEALAND FORCES **DURING THE FIRST WORLD** WAR.



WHERE DID IT ORIGINATE? **ON THE 25TH OF APRIL** 1915, AUSTRALIAN AND NEW ZEALAND SOLDIERSANZ FORMED PART OF THE ALLIED EXPEDITION THAT Lest SET OUT TO CAPTURE THE GALLIPOLI PENINSULA. THESE BECAME KNOWN AS ANZACS AND THE PRIDE THEY TOOK IN THAT NAME CONTINUES TO THIS DAY.



WHEN IS ANZAC DAY?

ANZAC DAY IS ON THE 25TH OF APRIL. LOTS OF ANZAC DAY DIFFERENT PEOPLE DO LOTS OF DIFFERENT THINGS AND Lest We Forget TRADITIONS ON ANZAC DAY LIKE THE DAWN SERVICE, WEAR ROSEMARY, WEAR POPPYS AND SEE FAMILY.



WHY IS ANZAC DAY IMPORTANT?

ANZAC DAY, 25 APRIL, IS PROBABLY AUSTRALIA'S ANZAC DAY MOST IMPORTANT NATIONAL OCCASION. IT MARKS THE Lest We Forget **ANNIVERSARY OF THE FIRST** CAMPAIGN THAT LED TO MAJOR CASUALTIES FOR AUSTRALIAN AND NEW ZEALAND FORCES DURING WORLD WAR **ONE AND COMMEMORATES ALL** THE CONFLICTS THAT FOLLOWED.

WHO WAS INVOLVED?

ANZACIS THE ACRONYM FOR AUSTRALIAN AND NEW ZEALAND NZAC DAY ARMY CORPS. THIS CORPS WAS CREATED EARLY IN THE GREAT WAR Lest We Forget OF 1914-18. IN DECEMBER 1914 THE AUSTRALIAN IMPERIAL FORCE AND NEW ZEALAND EXPEDITIONARY FORCE STATIONED IN EGYPT WERE PLACED UNDER THE COMMAND OF SUBSTITUTE GENERAL WILLIAM BIRDWOOD.



FUN FACTS!

THE 25TH APRIL WAS THE DAY WHEN THE AUSTRALIAN AND NEW ZEALAND ARMY CORPSANZAC DAY LANDED ON THE GALLIPOLI PENINSULA IN 1915. THE Lest We Forget **FIRST DAWN SERVICE FOR** ANZAC DAY WAS IN 1923. THE LAST SURVIVING ANZAC WAS ALEC CAMPBELL WHO DIED ON MAY 16, 2002.
