	 Measuring Capacity and volume: Students will use scaled instruments to measure and compare capacity. They will compare objects using familiar metric units of area and volume. 		
	 Measuring Mass: Students will use scaled instruments to measure, order and compare objects using familiar metric units of mass. 		
INQUIRY	Topic: Data is All Around Us		
TECHNOLOGY	Our inquiry unit for term 4 focuses on communication, digital technologies and data representation. In this unit students will make the connection between physical forms of communication and how data represented digitally is also a form of communication. Students will explore a variety of forms of communication, including morse code, braille, QR codes and algorithms.		
	In week 6 and 7 students will continue to discover more about secret messages and why they matter in our world. Coding is like a special way to send messages. Some messages are like secret puzzles that need to be solved before we can understand them. In our lessons, we'll find out that turning a word or phrase into a secret code is a cool way to show information in a different way.
