TEAM ENTRIES

- The best three results from competitors from the same school will make up the school team.
- All team members will compete as individuals.
- Competitors can only enter one horse which is to be ridden in all nominated events.

VENUE

All events will be held at The Hamilton and Alexandra College Equestrian Centre. Trucks can only enter the ground via North Boundary Rd entrance. Floats are asked to enter the front gates on the corner of Kent Rd and Macarthur St where parking is available above the junior school oval.

- All Dressage and Rider classes will be held on the school oval.
- The Handy Mount will be held within the Equestrian Centre.
- The Jumping Equitation will be conducted on the rubber arena in the Equestrian Centre.

DRESS

Competitors are required to wear the equestrian uniform nominated by their school with beige, banana, mango or cream jodhpurs or moleskins. Competitors must wear their own Armband, EA / PCAV approved helmet and boots at all times when mounted. Failure to wear the correct school uniform may result in elimination. Gear Check will be the responsibility of the School Team Manager. Incorrect gear in an event may result in Elimination.

CATERING

Food for snacks, lunch and drinks will be available from the food tent situated between the oval and the showjumping arena.

CAMPING

Limited overnight camping and horse yards (\$10.00 per horse per night) are available upon request by contacting kslade@eventsecretary.com.au or when submitting an entry online.

NUMBERS

Competitors are required provide their own bridle/saddle numbers and display on both sides of the horse with the allocated rider number.

TIMES

Draw will be sent out via email and uploaded to the College & Event Secretary websites on Wednesday 8th May 2019 www.hamiltoncollege.vic.edu.au under Current News; School News. They will also be emailed to team managers. Please ensure a clearly legible email address is included on the entry form. **Team managers should make copies of the draw and distribute it to all team members.** There can be no change of events after the closing date for entries.

DRESSAGE

- Dressage Tests are available on the EA website Preparatory will be ridden in a 20 x 40 arena.
- Secondary students should not enter the EA Preparatory Test unless a beginner.
- Elementary (3B) will be offered if sufficient entries.
- Dressage tests can be called.

JUMPING EQUITATION

Jumping Equitation is judged on the quality of the rider on the flat and over fences and consequently how well the horse jumps a series of fences.

HANDY MOUNT

The course will be posted at the Handy Mount area on the day. A time frame will be given eg. 1pm-2pm, competitors need to complete their Handy Mount within these times around their other classes.

RIDER CLASS

The Rider Class will be conducted as per a normal show ring class. All entries need to present to the judge at the time scheduled for the class to commence. All entries will be asked to work out by the Judge.
