

AIC FOOTBALL INFORMATION

Football is one of the most highly annually participated sports at Marist and we endeavour to place all students who signed on into a team. Due to the quick transition from Basketball and Tennis into Football and Rugby, we will need to have extra sessions and commence trials during the first season to get students ready for the Football season. We hope to avoid clashes with Basketball and Tennis sessions, but in some cases, this is not possible.

All schools will be broken into two pools of four schools similar to the first block. The first three weeks will be played as a round-robin with each team in the pool. After the first three rounds all schools within same the pool will be ranked. During the last round, which will be a finals round (12 September), schools will play the same ranked school in the opposite pool.

Each school will be responsible for hosting a certain age group during the finals round. A list of the host Colleges is found below. Year 5&6 teams will compete on Saturday mornings as usual, however, they will not play finals on Saturday 12 September. The Year 5&6 teams will play another normal round on this day as they **do not compete for premierships in the AIC competition. The opposition is yet to be determined.**

Pool B – Villanova, St. Laurence's, Iona and St. Peter's

- **Round 1** - Saturday 22 August vs St. Edmund's College (Year 5-8 – Home) (Years 9-12 – Away)
- **Round 2** - Saturday 29 August vs St. Patrick's College (Years 5-8 – Home) (Years 9-12 – Away)
- **Round 3** – Saturday 5 September vs. Padua College (Years 5-12 – Home)
- **Final Round** - Saturday 12 September. Each AIC College will be responsible for hosting a specific age group on this day as mentioned above.

Host Colleges for Finals Round - Year 5 – St. Laurence's College, Year 6 – St. Patrick's College, Year 7 – Padua College, Year 8 – Iona College, Year 9 – Villanova College, Year 10 – St Peter's Lutheran College, **Opens – Marist College Ashgrove.**

All draws will be published via the College APP by Tuesday afternoon prior to each weekend fixture.

PLEASE NOTE – Given the COVID-19 restrictions this year, the AIC Association will change the starting times for all games to allow for player and spectator movement and cleaning of venue.
