Can you help us in this fundraiser for our school? It is really easy. All you have to do is to go through your wardrobes over the next few weeks and put aside any items that you and your family will probably not wear again. On the day of the collection or during the week leading up to the collection date your child can take the bags of unwanted goods to school. A Southern Cross Recycling truck will be at the school on the morning of the collection date to receive the goods.

It couldn't be easier! The goods that can be reused by the charities are: clothes, footwear, Manchester & accessories such as hats, scarves, gloves, belts & hand-bags.

1. Sort

- Go through your wardrobes over the next two weeks and put aside any unwanted goods

2. Bag

- Place all the items into plastic bags

3. Take to school

- Take your unwanted goods to school during the week prior to the collection date or on the date itself
