1. Year 10 informed of enrollment requirements and processes for Year 11, 2022 at MDCC. Subject Selection Booklets, with subject information and criteria for subjects published. Year 10 students are encouraged to book appointments with our College Coaches ( <a href="#">link</a> ) to assist them with the process of subject selection.	Late Term 2
2. <i>Subject Information Sessions</i> will be held by Key Learning Area (KLA) Leaders during selected lessons. During this time students will be informed about Year 11 subjects and provided an opportunity to seek advice and clarification about their potential choices.	Late Term 2 and Early Term 3
