

# HOME LEARNING OUTLINE

Dear Parents/Guardians and Students,

We appreciate your support in helping to bring some continuity to your child's learning at home. This is obviously an unknown and stressful time for everyone so please just go slowly and spend some quality time together talking, learning and playing.

Home learning will be continued through the use of 'Google Classrooms' instruction with teacher feedback given. Please also refer to Mr Chatterton's Compass links for how to get your child logged in. You will need to download the following Apps (if you haven't already) onto a device:

\* Google Classroom

**Grade 5 (all students need to join this to receive updates): o5pgf4l**

Then, join ONLY your child's class below so they can upload work and receive feedback from their teacher.

Throughout the day, where possible, please allow some time and encourage students to complete the following learning sessions. Each session should be approximately 30-40 mins including listening to the instructions, completing the task, and uploading work samples if necessary for individual and group lesson feedback. Your classroom teacher will assign specific days for individual feedback.

Reading:

- Instruction via Google Classroom for session
- Independent/Supported Reading (15mins)
- Follow up activity
- Upload work sample for teacher feedback (when required)

### Spelling:

- Words Their Way Keynote 15 minutes every day (available on Google Classrooms)
- Words Their Way Spelling Test to be uploaded to teacher each Friday

### Writing:

- Instruction via Google Classroom for session
- Independent Writing/Spelling practise (20-25 mins)
- Editing Writing: Read writing 3 times (1. Does it make sense? 2. Check and edit the punctuation 3. Edit spelling using word list or by having another go)
- Upload work sample and/or any questions for teacher feedback

### Numeracy:

- Instruction via Google Classroom for warm up activity (10mins) - get parent/guardian to check. Maths toolkits to support.
- Instruction via Google Classroom for session
- Complete learning task (15-20 mins)
- Upload work sample for teacher feedback and any questions (when required)

### CBL

- Google Classroom will be used to set a variety of challenges that focus on different areas of the STEM curriculum
- Challenges will be an ongoing project that students work on over a number of days
- Reflections and prompts on Google Classroom will occur during the week
- Upload completed work for teacher feedback

We encourage parents and students to create a little home learning timetable/framework so students can see how their day may look. Try to include when they will have breakfast, snack, recess, lunch etc. so the day is broken into small achievable blocks like a school day. This will help your child to not feel overwhelmed by the change to their routine. Don't forget to dedicate time for free play, physical activity and family time.

We will be available online through Google Classroom from 9:00-11:00am each day. If work is submitted after this or emails are sent, we will endeavour to give feedback and reply before 3:30pm each day ready for the following day's learning. Please reach out to talk through any issues that arise or for learning support.
