Pack your emergency kit

- Being prepared includes having your own food, water, medication and other essential supplies to be able to look after yourself and your family for at least 72 hours.
- A collection of items your household may need for survival during the emergency and items to help you recover after an emergency. An emergency kit must be prepared to suit your family's individual needs.

In the event an ERC is established the location will be announced via Vic Emergency and the Emergency Broadcasters.

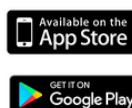
Important Apps and contacts


To install an app on your phone, you need to:

1. Open the app store on your phone (PlayStore, App Store)
2. Search for the app you want to install
3. Select the app from the search results
4. Tap INSTALL (these are all FREE app's)
5. Wait for the app to finish installing.
6. Tap OPEN to launch the app from the app store, or tap the app's icon in your app list
