Retreat, Junee Reefs

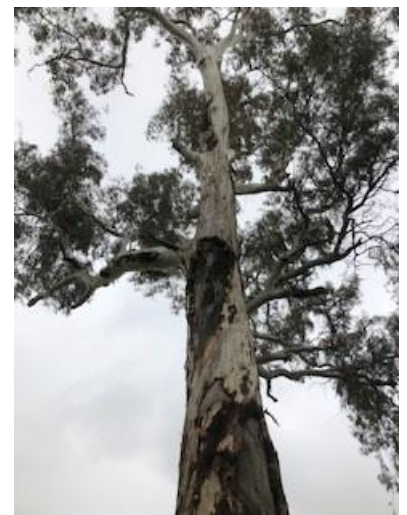
The Wagga NAIDOC Committee invite young people aged 12-18yrs to attend an overnight cultural camp at 'Retreat' within Junee Reefs.

The NAIDOC Committee will be providing supervision and support during the camp. They will also help young people plan how they will share the knowledge they have learnt when they return to community in the coming months.

Any young person showing cold and flu symptoms will not be permitted on the camp. If your child is experiencing cold and flu symptoms, please let us know prior to the camp.

- Guest speakers from the National Museum
- Star gazing (weather permitting)
- All meals, drinks, snacks are provided.
