Works alert – Piling works

The Victorian Government is removing 18 dangerous level crossings on the Frankston line, including at Charman Road and Park Road in Cheltenham and at Balcombe Road in Mentone, to improve safety and reduce congestion.

As part of these works, piling will take place to strengthen the ground for the new rail trench walls. A piling rig will drill holes, ranging from 15 to 50 metres deep, along the rail corridor. A steel cage will be lowered into each hole and concrete poured in. Up to six piling rigs will be in use at any one time between Mentone and Cheltenham.

Some properties may experience moderate levels of vibration. This is normal. We will monitor vibrations to ensure our works comply with industry standards. If you are concerned, you can contact us via the details below.

Activities taking place

- Piling works will take place along the west of the rail line between Mentone Station and Warrigal Road during December
- Works to prepare the ground for the piling rig will take place from mid-November

What to expect

- Some noise and vibration
- Workers, vehicles and equipment, including an increase in heavy vehicles on local streets delivering equipment and removing material from the work site
- Activities will take place from **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am to 1pm Saturdays** – if any works are required outside these times, we will let you know
