

This program is part of the Set Up for Success initiative, a **free** program prompting lifelong skills for both young children and their families. We invite children from birth to five years old to attend along with a caregiver.

Learning for Life is run out of our Early Learning Centre every Wednesday from 1.30pm to 2.30pm. The ELC is our former Kindergarten House and is accessible from both our Sandy Bay Road and Nelson Road entrances. We welcome families to start their learning journey from Week Two and continue with us until the end of each school term. Our experienced Early Years staff develop weekly programs to meet the needs of children within our local community, inspired by Christian values. Each week our Learning for Life sessions will support the holistic development of individual children. As part of the learning experience, parents and carers are responsible for their children at all times during the sessions.
