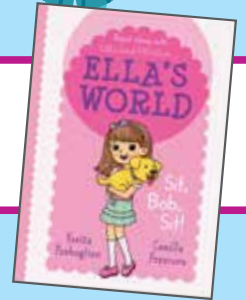
- 1 Researchers say that six is the magic number of books to read to keep from regressing over the holidays. Choose six awesome books and try to read one per week.

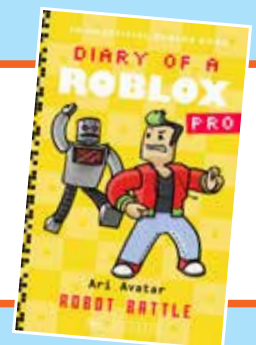

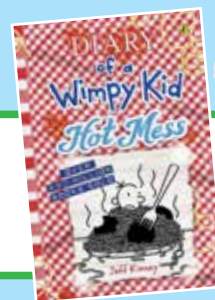
