What we've been up to in the past fortnight!

Over the last week, we have changed the room setting in GOSH for the children to have more space to explore their developmental and life skills with their friends during after school care. We have organised a space for the children's school bags, the children can put their bags in the back room and they can access this area to get their things inside GOSH.

We are promoting the children's talents. The children are able to perform singing, dancing and playing musical instruments at GOSH. In order to share the experience and skills with their friends and enjoy this experience together. (Photo. 1)

At after school care at GOSH, we are encouraging the children to eat healthy snacks. Every week we have a cooking activity. The children can participate in this activity, cook with friends along with assistance from the educator to develop the children's health and well-being, social skills and collaborative skills. We also set up a rest area for children in GOSH to make sure that children can have a rest and do quiet activities in this area based on the children's needs. The children were giving great feedback of the rest area and helped educators to set up the space. They were playing and doing quiet activities nicely in the rest area. (Photo.3)

As we have space to do physical activities in GOSH, we were setting up the table to play "TABLE TENNIS" indoors. The children can score their friends and take turns to play. This indoor activity is a great activity for the children to develop their eye and hand coordination and self-regulate when they play games. (Photo.4)

Construction activity is one of the great creativity activities for children. The children were building "The MOUTAIN" from the giant blocks. They were discussing with each other, led by the older children and together they came up with the mountain idea. (Photo. 5)

In the afternoon, we were taking some activities outside to get some fresh air and sun in the afternoon. The girls were really enjoying making "POM POMS". They are making the giant pompoms to use as cushions for the rest area. (Photo. 6)



What we have planned for the next fortnight!

- We will be celebrating national recycling week. We will be discussing sustainable practices in GOSH. We will put up posters after the discussion and begin to separate all scrap food from the general waste bin and encourage the children to use the recycled paper.
- We are putting up a Christmas tree to replace the previous family tree and encourage the children to give ideas of how they would like their Christmas tree decorated. We will be doing art and craft to make our own decorations for it.
- On the 16th of November, we will be simulating a "Medical Emergency" from 4 pm onwards.
