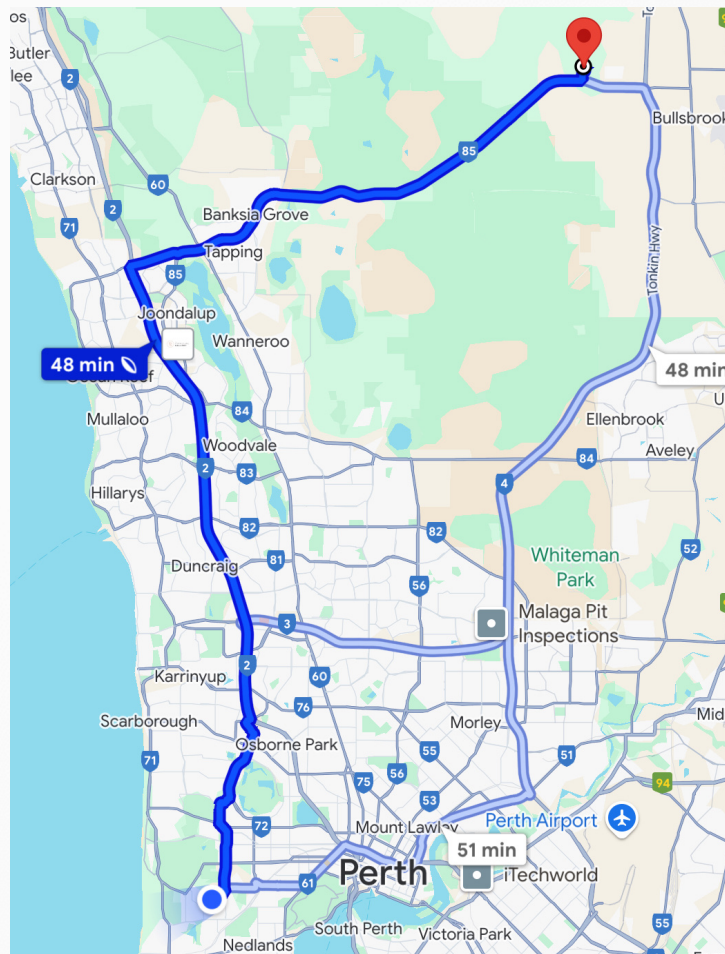
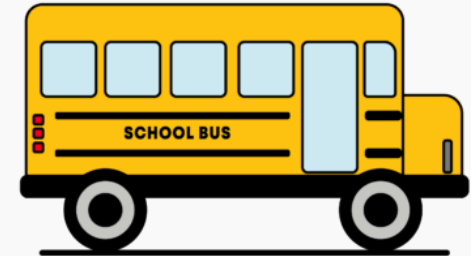

Rock Climbing

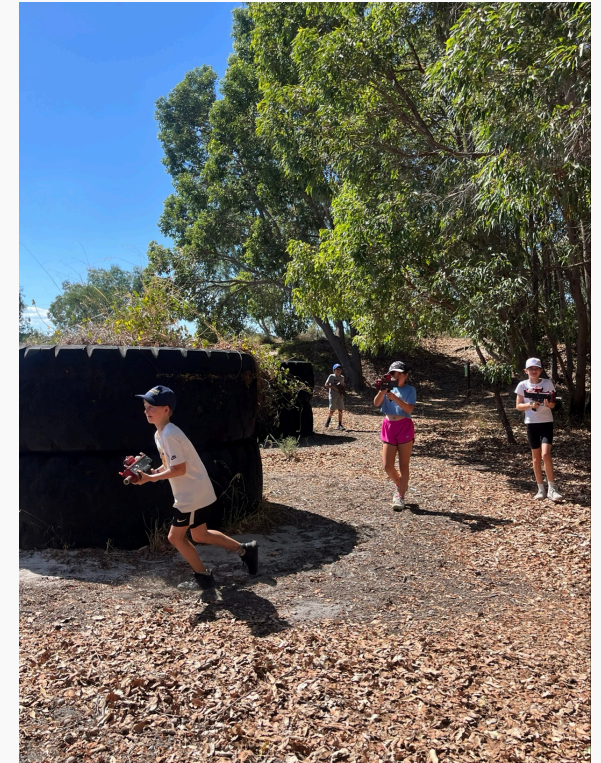
