<p>Acrostic: Make an acrostic poem using the letters of the word.</p> <p>Super Cool Happy On time Outdoor play Learning</p>	<p>Blocks/objects: Arrange blocks or other objects to form the letters of the word.</p> 	<p>Sewing: Create words by stitching letters onto fabric or card.</p> 	<p>Body Shapes: Make each letter of the word by bending and stretching your body into shapes.</p> 	<p>Musical Clap: Clap and spell the word by creating a different beat.</p> 
<p>Computer: Type words onto a computer. Try different fonts.</p> 	<p>Word Shapes: Write the word in lower case and draw around the shape. Think about the shape.</p> 	<p>Fancy Letters: Draw words in large block letters and decorate each letter with a design.</p> 	<p>Play Dough: Mould the letters from Play Dough or roll the dough into coils to form the letters.</p> 	<p>Song and dance: Sing the letters of the word to a tune and add actions.</p> 
<p>Magazine cut: Find the letters that make up the word in a magazine. Cut them out and glue them onto the paper.</p> 	<p>Bubble Writing: Write or trace the words in a scrapbook.</p> 	<p>Magnetic Letters: Use magnetic letters to spell the words. Keep them on your fridge!</p> 	<p>Sand Tracing: Write words in a sand tray.</p> 	<p>Paper Chains: Write letters of the word on strips of paper and link them together.</p>
