Could you be saving more?

Child Care Subsidy (CCS) will change from 10 July 2023, which could have a positive impact on your family. We encourage you to make a claim with Centrelink and connect your CCS to your Camp Australia account.

- If your family earns under \$530,000, you may receive increased CCS (percentage will depend on your family's income)
- The income limit to get the maximum CCS is increasing from 85% to 90% for families earning up to \$80,000
- Families with more than one child aged 5 or under can get a higher rate for one of their children in care

DIY Science Experiments with Household Items



Blow it up!

You will need:

Baking Soda, Vinegar, Plastic Bottle, Plastic Funnel

Instructions:

1. Using the funnel pour vinegar into your bottle. You only need to fill about 1/3 of the bottle.
2. Using another (dry) funnel pour baking soda into your balloon. Fill the balloon approximately halfway.
3. Cover the top of the bottle with the balloon. Make sure you don't let the baking soda spill into the bottle too early.
4. When ready, lift your balloon and let the baking soda fall into the vinegar.
5. Watch as the mixture fizzes, bubbles and expands your balloon!
6. Discuss how the baking soda & vinegar produce a gas which fills the balloon.



The Science Behind It

Baking soda and the vinegar create an ACID-BASE reaction. When mixed they create a gas, carbon dioxide. Gases need room to spread, so the carbon dioxide fills the bottle and then moves into the balloon inflating it.

The dedicated zones in Your OSHC offer a unique space for children to engage in child-led activities before and after school. Each zone offers appropriate resources to give children opportunities to be creative, imaginative, hands-on and engaged, with learning outcomes that support our framework.

We have 8 different zones in Your OSHC but here are 2 examples in detail of what the children could be doing on any given day.



Construction City

A safe, dedicated area to engage in various forms of construction building, stacking and making. This area is designed with an array of construction and vehicle tracks, allowing children the creative freedom to construct using various equipment. Some examples of these are LEGO®, connector straws, Polydron blocks, Zoobs, train tracks and vehicles, wooden blocks and recycled boxes.



Crafty Collection

Area with an array of craft resources to encourage children's creative expression. This area supports the budding artist and ignites the creative flair of children as they have access to a wide variety of resources including; construction paper, glue, stencils, pens, pencils, markers, crayons, chalk, pom poms, google eyes, feathers, pipe cleaners, icy pole sticks, scissors, tape, stickers, fabric, rulers and painting equipment.

Your OSHC will introduce tailored activities in service to encourage children to take part in environmentally friendly projects.


