Celebrate our diverse community through music, art, interactive workshops, children's activities, bilingual storytime, food and culture.

The festival kicks off with cultural performances by Djirri Djirri Dancers, PICAA, Pearl Afrikulture Rhythms, Wiradjuri singer-songwriter Ruby Mae, L2R Dance and MC Candy Bowers, alongside a Bowery Theatre line-up including Resonate Acoustic: Youth Music Showcase, a weaving workshop with Mata'ala Pasifika Weave Mamas and Dance Lab Live with Sheena Chundee.
