## Dear IPS Community,

The Ivanhoe Primary School Council consists of 15 members made up parents / guardians of current students as well as Department of Education employees.

Terms are generally two years, so approximately half the School Council is renewed each year. Being a school councillor means taking part in shaping the future of the school. You will need to attend several meetings each term (on a Wednesday evening) and may need to develop new skills.

In most cases you need to be elected to become a school council member. All parents and guardians from the school can vote. The timeline is in the table above.

Before or on Friday the 27<sup>th</sup>January - I will call for nominations for Ivanhoe Primary School Council and make the nomination forms available to you on COMPASS / Class dojo and in the school newsletter.

A parent may self-nominate or be nominated by another parent.

Just make sure you use the correct form when it is published and get it in to the school office before the 10<sup>th</sup> of February (at 4 pm).
