Literacy & Numeracy Update

Students have continued to explore the 5 senses in content knowledge. Last week we focused on the sense of taste. Students discussed foods that taste sweet, salty, bitter and sour. They even were able to categorise the foods in their lunch box and describe what flavour they have! Students have also been able to write questions about foods such as “What foods can taste bitter?” They then have attempted answering these questions with a statement.

During Numeracy, students have been looking at numbers that add together to make 10, focusing on part-part-whole strategies. We have played lots of different games and have become super speedy with our tens facts!
