

UNIFORM POLICY

RATIONALE - Beliefs & Values:

Uniform is compulsory – Sports uniform, Summer uniform and Winter uniform.

Summer Uniform to be worn in Terms 1 and 4.

Winter Uniform to be worn in Terms 2 and 3.

Sport uniform consists of school shorts/skorts and polo top.

A copy of the School Uniform price list is available from the office or from our website.

Families can purchase uniforms online via a newsletter link.

Please ensure that the children are correctly attired at all times at school.

This includes black shoes (including all-black runners) or black boots. Any coloured runners can be worn with the sports uniform on P.E and Outdoor Education days.

All polo tops and windcheaters should have the Holy Cross logo.

Coats do not require a school logo, however must be navy blue or black in colour.

The Uniform Shop operates with volunteer help every Friday morning from 8:30 am in the uniform shop, located opposite the staffroom.

WHAT MAY BE WORN:

Summer Uniform:

- Summer dress with navy blue socks and black shoes
- OR
- Skort/navy shorts with pale blue polo, navy blue socks and black shoes
- Navy blue shorts with pale blue polo shirt, navy blue socks and black shoes.
- Holy Cross windcheater
- Navy blue/black coat
- Wide Brim Hat Term 1 & 4

Winter Uniform:

- Winter dress/skirt with pale blue polo, navy blue socks/tights and black shoes
- OR

- Girl's navy blue pants with pale blue polo, navy blue socks and black shoes
- Navy Trousers with pale blue polo, navy blue socks and black shoes
- Holy Cross windcheater OR polar fleece jumper
- Navy blue/black coat

Sports Uniform:

- Skort/navy shorts/navy tracksuit pants with Holy Cross House sports top
- White sport socks and runners
- Holy Cross windcheater OR polar fleece jumper
- Navy blue/black coat

Accessories:

Earrings: studs or small sleepers only.

Other jewellery should not be worn with the exception of discrete necklaces and watches. Smart watches need to be set to school mode or handed in to the front office at the beginning of the day and collected at the end of the day.

Long hair (shoulder length or longer) needs to be tied up for both boys and girls - hair ties/headbands/scrunchies and hair clips need to be in the school colours. No large hair accessories are permitted.

Hair must be a natural colour only.

Makeup and temporary body art should not be worn.

Fake fingernails are not permitted.

Nail polish is not permitted with the exception of clear varnish.

Management of school uniform:

Parents are asked to ensure that uniform requirements and grooming are adhered to. Children are expected to wear the correct school and sport uniform on the appropriate days.

Children not wearing the correct uniform need to have a note of explanation from their family. This will be followed up by the classroom teacher.

If an item of clothing is not on this list it may not be worn
